Oral Quiz

A Student B's own answers

Sample answers:

- Yes. I'd tell [my boss because it might affect my work.] / No, I don't think I would. [That would make me uncomfortable.]
- I'd live in [China]. [All my friends and family are there.]
- Yes, I do. [Traveling by myself makes me feel free.] / No, I don't. [I'm not very confident, so I prefer traveling with family or friends.]
- I admire [flexibility]. [Flexible people are easier to get along with.]

B Student A's own answers

Sample answers:

- Yes, I would. [I like to be honest with my friends. It helps us have a healthy relationship.] / No, I wouldn't. [My friend might feel embarrassed.]
- I'd like to meet [Daniel Radcliffe]. [I love his movies!]
- Yes, I do. [I can take my time.] / No, I don't. [It makes me feel lonely.]
- I think the word [*dedicated*] describes me best. [I always finish what I start.]

C Student B's questions

- If Alex had ten million dollars, what would he do first?
- Do any of Alex's wishes show that he is a dedicated husband and father? Which ones?
- Which of his wishes do you think is the most creative? Why?
- If you were Alex's wife, which wish would you ask him to change? Why?

Student A's answers

Sample answers:

- He'd buy a boat and sail around the world by himself.
- Yes. Alex's second, fourth, and fifth wishes show that he is a dedicated husband and father.
- I think his [last] wish is the most creative. [People don't usually ask their spouses about wish lists!]
- If I were Alex's wife, I'd ask him to change his [first] wish. [I think he should take his family with him.]

D Student A's questions

- If Nora had ten million dollars, what would she do first?
- Do any of Nora's wishes show that she might be creative? Which?
- Which of her wishes do you admire? Why?
- If you were Nora's friend, which wish would you ask her to change? Why?

Student B's answers

Sample answers:

- She'd buy herself new clothes (at the trendiest stores).
- Yes. Her wish to move to Paris and become a painter shows that she's probably creative. Also, her third wish shows that she likes art.
- I admire her [third and fifth wishes] because they [show she's considerate].
- If I were Nora's friend, I'd ask her to change her [second] wish. [I wouldn't want her to move so far away!]
