Empty Boat Found Near Tasmania

An Australian sea rescue team is searching for three men who disappeared while they were sailing in the Pacific Ocean. Their empty boat was found forty miles from the island of Tasmania.

Everything on board looked normal. Things were in order, the computers were turned

on, their cell phones were on the table, and the table was set for dinner, but there were no people. "The last message from the men was five days ago," said Jack Wilson, a member of the rescue team. "Since then, no one has heard from them."

The three men started their journey in Tasmania last weekend and were heading for Canberra. The boat was seen by a plane on Wednesday, but the rescue team only got to it today. "We hope the men haven't fallen into the ocean," said Wilson. "We believe they went ashore somewhere and the boat went adrift. We still hope to find them sitting on a beach and doing well."
