Have you been thinking about going out to a new restaurant, movie, or club in your area but don't know where to go? Why not go online and try Zagat?

The Zagat Survey started as a hobby for two New Yorkers, Tim and Nina Zagat. They loved to dine out at good places, so they asked their friends to write reviews of their favorite New York restaurants. That was the beginning of their first guide, the highly successful *Zagat NYC Restaurant Survey*. Now Zagat has surveys for restaurants in over 100 countries around the world. And the company has

expanded to include guides for hotels, resorts, nightclubs, movies, theater, and even places to play golf.

It's called a survey because Zagat grades places by popular vote. Anyone can send in a review of a place listed in one of the guides, and that review will become part of the score or rating. Hundreds, and sometimes thousands, of people may rate one place. It seems to work. People who use Zagat say its ratings are more accurate than reviews done by so-called experts.
